Report on Progress:

The Chairman gave an account of the work carried out during the past year and outlined proposals for the future. He made an appeal to residents to observe the 15 m.p.h. limit (see also Chairman's note)

Submission of Accounts: The accounts for 1960-61 were adopted

Mandate for future work and subscriptions.

Several residents of Upway did not wish Upway to be included in any scheme of making up. One resident suggested scarifying the surface instead of filling potholes but it was considered that this would be more costly.

The proportioning of the cost of any making up was considered and it was agreed that this should be divided equally between residents rather than assessed on a frontage basis.

The Chairman then put three motions to the meeting: these were: -

i) that all roads should be made up,

ii) that all roads except Upway should be made up, iii) that the subscription should be increased to £10 or £12.

Voting was: Motion (i) 19 for out of 36 " (ii) 25 " " " 36 " (iii) 22 " " " 36

The Chairman considered that as there was considerable support from the meeting for motion (ii) a referendum should be held. Meanwhile it was arranged that the subscription should be continued at 6gns.

Election of Committee:

Mr. Ogden would be leaving the district shortly but all other members were willing to stand again. The Committee was then re-elected.

Mr. Simons expressed the appreciation of residents of Mr. Ogden's valuable work as Chairman of the Committee. He felt that besides the benefit of improvements to the roads, Mr. Ogden had contributed to building up a spirit of community on the estate.

Appointment of Auditor:

Mr. Brightwell was willing to stand again and was elected
